1. Per B's clue, H can only be in Hole 1 with an unknown woman in a cart, either in R12C1 or R12C4. Block the rest of R12.

2. This isolates M on the Hole 3 flag. K must be with M in R2.

3. Hole 3 is an odd-numbered hole, so it must have 3 occupants. O is in R1 and he cannot be on a golf tee (per G's clue), this isolates O in R1C13.

4. J is either in R11C5 or R14C9, block the intersecting squares. This isolates E on the Hole 6 flag, then J.

5. Hole 4 must have two occupants (even-number rule), and Hole 5 must have one occupant (odd-number rule). K cannot be in C13-C16, this isolates K in R2C11.

6. Because someone is in Hole 5 in R15 or R16, Hole 6 cannot have four occupants. It must have two occupants (even-number rule): E and J. Block the rest of Hole 6. Whoever is in R16 must be the person in Hole 5, block the rest of Hole 5. The person in R15 is in Hole 1.

7. This isolates G on the last tee, then someone in R15C1.

8. The woman in the cart must be F, with I in C3. H is in R15C1.

9. Because Hole 2 is even-numbered, G must be paired with somebody. This person must be in R4C6.

10. This isolates D on the last square beside a flag, then I.

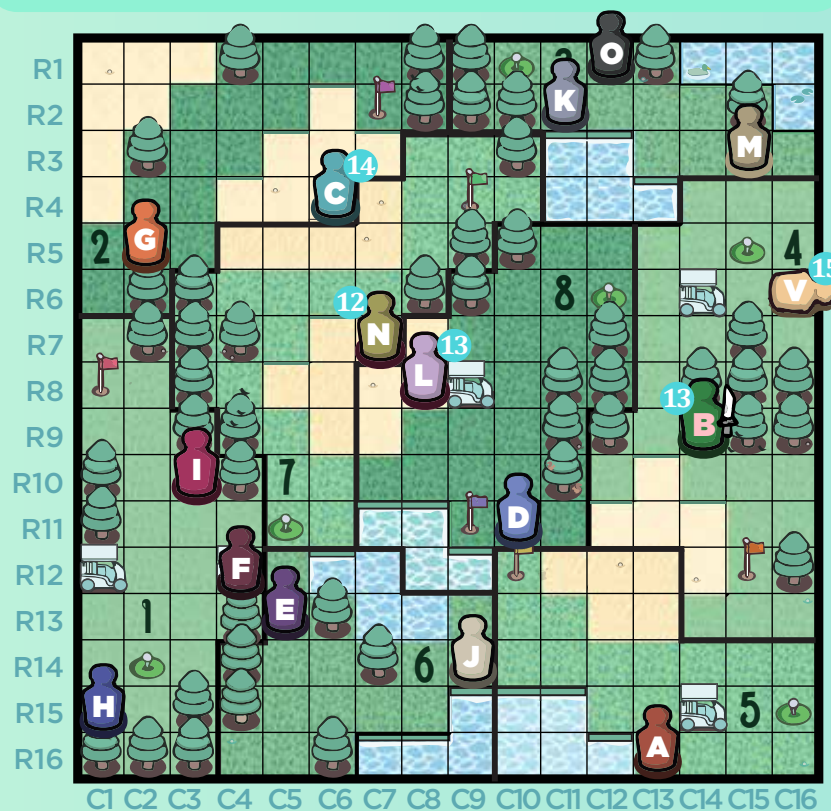
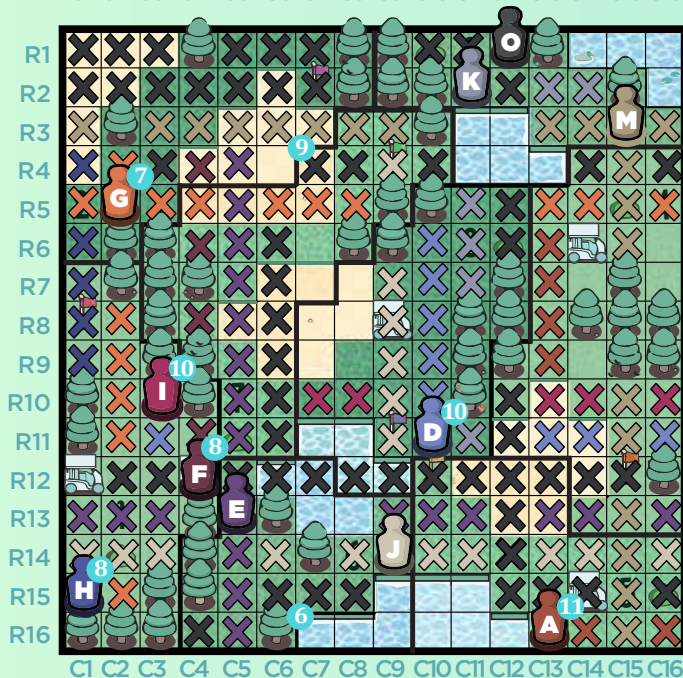
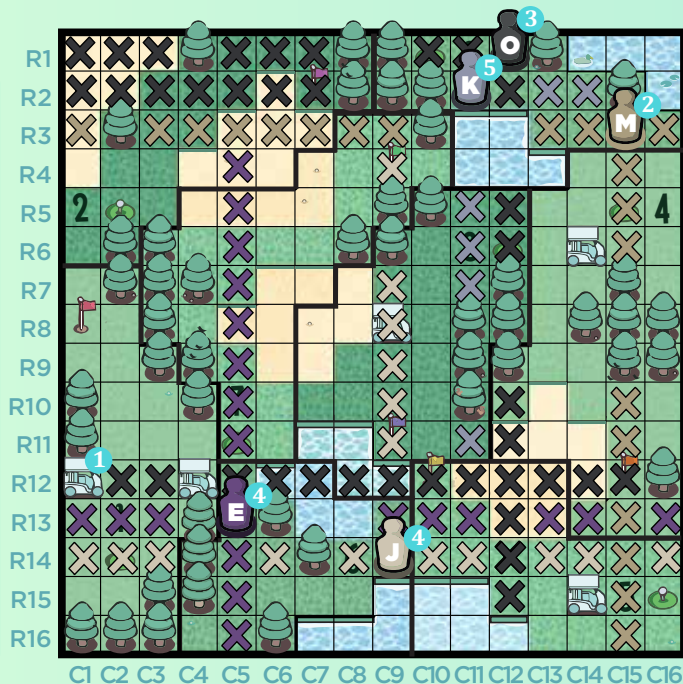
11. This isolates A on the last square beside water.

12. N cannot be in Hole 2 (per F's clue) and she cannot be in Hole 8 (per L's clue). This isolates N in the last sand square in Hole 7.

13. This isolates B, then L in Hole 8.

14. C cannot be in C16, so he must be in Hole 2 with G.

15. This isolates V alone with D. Berta is the murderer!
